

220.10 AIR POLLUTION CONTROL FEES.

Fees are collected by SCHD's Akron Regional Air Quality Management District shall be as provided in the following table:

EMISSION UNIT PERMIT PROCESSING AND/OR INSPECTION FEES:	
<p>Any person who owns and/or operates a facility containing one or more sources of air contaminant emissions shall pay an annual fee in accordance with the following schedule for the examination, handling, review and storage of applications, reports, notifications, and/or inspection of each emissions unit. The annual fee assessed shall be based on the facility status of the previous calendar year, as of December 31. Annual fees shall be invoiced and paid annually. All fees are due within 30 days of receipt of invoice. A ten percent (10%) late charge will be assessed on all delinquent payments.</p> <p>Allowable emissions for the facility is defined as the summation of the total allowable emissions for each regulated pollutant emitted at a rate in excess of 1 ton per year, including fugitive emissions.</p>	
(a) Title V facility with allowable yearly emissions of:	
1) Up to 50 tons	\$ 1000
2) More than 50 tons through 250 tons	\$ 2000
3) More than 250 tons	\$ 4000
Note: the fee for local and state government facilities will be charged at 50% of the above rate.	
(b) FEPTIO facility with allowable yearly emissions of:	
1) Up to 25 tons	\$ 250
2) More than 25 tons through 50 tons	\$ 500
3) More than 50 tons	\$ 1000
(c) Gasoline Dispensing Facility (GDF) fee (Includes facilities complying with "Permit by Rule (PBR) Exemption" OAC 3745-31-01(A)(4)(i))	\$ 100
(d) Dry Cleaning Facility	\$ 100
(e) Facility that is only subject to PBR, but is not a GDF Note: Entities operating multiple back-up power generators will be charged a maximum of \$800.	\$ 50
(f) Other Facilities with Allowable yearly emissions of:	
1) Up to 5 tons	\$ 100
2) More than 5 tons through 25 tons	\$ 200
3) More than 25 tons through 75 tons	\$ 400
4) More than 75 tons	\$ 800
RETEST FEES:	
Retest fees for emissions tests conducted at facilities are billed following the successful completion of the testing program. All fees are due within 30 days of receipt of invoice. A ten percent (10%) late charge will be assessed on all delinquent payments.	
(g) Each required retest	\$ 500
ASBESTOS NOTIFICATIONS:	
The fees for processing asbestos renovation/demolition notifications shall be based upon the project size as follows:	
(h) Less than 160 square or 260 linear feet of Regulated Asbestos Containing Materials (RACM)	\$ 50
(i) Greater than or equal to 160 square or 260 linear feet and less than 5,000 feet (square, linear or combination) of RACM	\$ 75
(j) Greater than or equal to 5,000 feet (square, linear, or combination) of RACM	\$ 100
(k) Revisions to the notification, regardless of the base fee	\$25
Notes: This fee schedule does NOT apply to unregulated projects or to volunteer fire departments submitting a demolition notice for fire training exercises conducted in asbestos-free residential structures.	

Payments and an appropriate survey should be sent in with the completed notification form.	
OPEN BURNING PERMIT FEES: The fee for processing open burning permit requests; Notes: This fee does not apply to fire training exercises. Payments should be submitted with the completed notification.	\$ 50
